Mistawasis Nêhiyawak High School and Chief Mistawasis School:

2. Teachers will communicate with parents/students weekly/bi-weekly to ensure resources are provided, to support students and families and to support families via referral if needs are identified – i.e. / mental health, nutrition.

Mistawasis Early Learning (Day Care/Head Start):

Day Care Centre will remain **CLOSED** until further notice.

Head Start
